Warnings are unique exceptions in that they only send information to the `stderr` stream in order to obtain more details about a specific code segment. Below is a description of them:

Code	Message	Additional details
TW000	Unknown.	Unknown and unexpected warning.
TW001	Note: %s	Displays a hint directive that contains information about a piece of code that is <code>deprecated</code> , <code>experimental</code> , <code>platform</code> dependent, <code>unimplemented</code> , or custom.
TW002	Attempting to allocate a large number of bytes.	For instance, it shows up when you attempt to make a giant a array or allocate a significant amount of memory for a pointer.
